I. Important Due Dates

● Submission of Project Briefing & Registration	June 10, 2017
● Notification of First Screening Results	June 15, 2017
● Final Project Package	June 15, 2017
● Final Exhibition & Awards	July 12-14, 2017

* The registration fee for GCSI projects is USD 60 or RMB 400 per project.

II. Required Submissions

- Preliminary evaluation: submit a completed Project Briefing Form which describes the essence of the innovation with emphasis on features of the innovation, systematic methods on how to arrive at the innovation, contributions, and current implementation situation. Optional brief background of the authors/inventors can also be attached. Please download the Project Briefing Form from the GCSI web site or send request e-mail to icsi2017@i-sim.org.
- Final competition: Those projects passed the preliminary evaluation are invited to submit additional project package in English for the final review which includes:
 - When presenting in person on site:
 - A **powerpoint presentation file is required for submission.**
 - An **optional video** explanation in less than 25 minutes is **not required** but encouraged.
 - A **poster** file. The poster is used to convey the key concept and achievements of your project. The contents of the Poster file is up to the team's discretion. It can be extracted from up to 16 pages of your existing power-point presentation materials or up to 16 A4 pages of .doc (docx) file which is ready to print. **All information of the poster must fit into one A0 size page.**
 - When no author will be presenting on site: The request items as the same as above. However, the video is required if none of the team members will be presenting on site.
- Contents of the poster, presentation file, video should include at least the following components: Project Title, Team Members & Affiliations (names, organization, company, country, etc.), Problem Statement, Systematic Process/Tools which were used to solve the problem, Results, Impacts/Benefits/Constraints of the project.
- File name convention: Category -Project_Name-Author_FamilyName-Submission_Date. For example: A -CMP_invention-Clinton-110201. Submission date format: -yymmdd.
- Each project team can be of single or multiple persons. There is no limit on the number of projects a person/team can submit.
